**VARIETAL:** Chardonnay

### TASTING NOTES

*This Chardonnay is complex with crisp acidic structure and ripe fruit characteristics.*

**AROMAS:** Ripe stone fruit, vanilla

**FLAVORS:** Crisp apples, pears

**FINISH:** Crisp, round

### WINEMAKING

*Alison Crowe, Winemaker*

*Individual blocks underwent malolactic fermentation separately to develop balanced acidity and roundness. Finished in medium, medium + toasted oak barrels.*

**VINEYARDS:** Sandy bench land, well-drained soils, marine layer, certified sustainable

**GRAPES:** Non-GMO
