Sea stacks are geological formations created over eons by wind and waves. Sea Stack Pinot Noir is a blend from Santa Barbara, Monterey, and Sonoma Counties where these tall sea stacks stand sentinel at the edge of the ocean. Sea Stack Pinot Noir is a reflection of these growing regions.



APPELLATION: 56% Monterey, 33% Sonoma, 11% Santa Barbara



VARIETAL: Pinot Noir



ALCOHOL: 13.7%

TASTING NOTES

Sea Stack Pinot Noir is complex yet approachable with strong oak structure, nuances of black currants and raspberries and a smooth finish.

AROMAS: Ripe cherry, blackberry

FLAVORS: Strawberry, plum, vanilla

FINISH: Complex, long

WINEMAKING

Alison Crowe, Winemaker

Grapes harvested at night, briefly cold soaked, and small vat fermented to max 85°F. Underwent 100% malolactic fermentation and racked in oak for 16 months. A mixture of light and medium + toast oak.

VINEYARDS: Coastal, well-drained soil, certified sustainable

GRAPES: Non-GMO
